The walkways and entrance areas were paved in close assembly with SF-Rima™ for ease of walking. Rain water enters the gravel filled joints. In the parking areas, the pavers were installed in a wider assembly and the joints filled with a soil-grass mix to allow some water infiltration and to enhance the “green” aspect of this facility.



Columbia Springs provides environmental education opportunities for the community and students of all ages. It is located on one hundred acres of urban greenspace at the historic Vancouver Trout Hatchery.

In 2002, when parking lots and walkways required re-pavement, the logical choice was to use an ecological concrete paving system which allows rain water to infiltrate through the pavement thereby avoiding runoff. At the same time providing filtering of pollutions.
